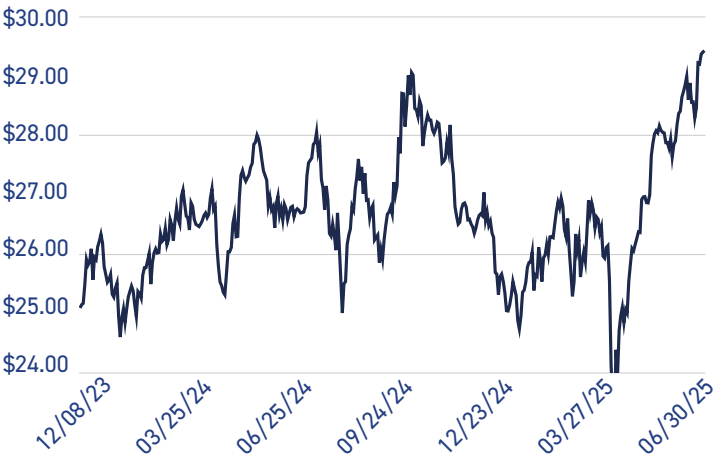

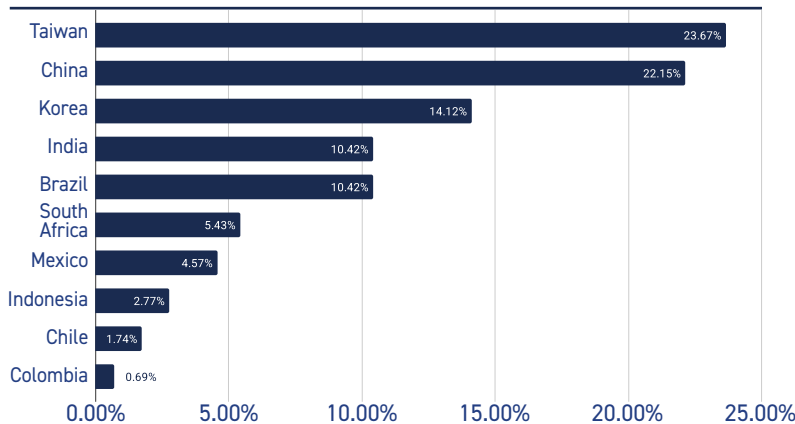

#### Definitions:
